Playground – work on the playground had almost been completed. It was noted that the Fete Committee had decided to purchase a baby swing for the playground. Clerk to apply to Stratford Council for the payment of the grant.

Rotation of Councillors – as the next elections are due to be held in April 2002, it was agreed that in the New Year a notice would be sent to each house in the village advising people of the elections and inviting them to attend to council meetings if they were interested in standing..

Reading Room Meals – it was agreed that D. Whittlesea and L. Hope-Frost would produce a leaflet regarding the meals, which would be sent to each household in the village. If there was sufficient interest the council would pursue the matter further and purchase a microwave.

Heating in the Reading Room – the quote from Mark Johnson was still outstanding. C. Worrall agreed to chase.

- 6) Correspondence:

Planning – a) Permission was given to the Parish Council to lift the crowns of the yew trees at the burial ground.

b) An application to prune six lime trees in the village. The council had no representation to make.

Warwickshire County Council – a letter advising that the cost of the proposed street light would be in the region of £2,700. It was agreed that a meeting should be arranged to discuss the cost. Clerk to reply.
