Recent incidents across the Snitterfield, Wellesbourne, Kineton and Burton Dassett area

Incident 161 22/01/17
Burton Dassett country park
Between approximately 0900 – 1900 hours 22/01/17
damage was caused to the car park meter by means unknown

Incident 55 30/01/17
Spitfire housing development, Gaydon
Between approximately 1300 28/01/17 – 0700
30/01/17 a completed but unoccupied house was entered by smashing a double glazed window and a log burning stove and kitchen appliances were stolen

Incident 135 04/02/17 St Michael's church, Warmington Between 28/01/17 – 04/02/17 lead was stolen from the roof of the church

Incident 226 05/02/17

Bloor Homes housing development, Kineton Between approximately 1500 04/02/17 – 1400 05/02/17 a completed but unoccupied house was entered by smashing a window and kitchen appliances, tools and a vacuum cleaner were stolen
